<p><i>Bouteloua gracilis</i> 'Blonde Ambition' PP22048 Blue Grama Grass</p>	<p>Blue-green bladed leaves during the summer months turn in the fall to straw-yellow and seed heads bend horizontally. Blue-grey foliage forms a clump at the base, eventually turning brown, sometimes with hues of orange and red, in the fall. Compact and low growing habit. Full sun, drought tolerant. A warm-season grass.</p>	<p>H 30" W 26-30" Zone 3</p>	
<p><i>Calamagrostis acutiflora</i> 'Karl Foerster' Reed Grass</p>	<p>Wheat-like seed heads with compact habit. Provides great backdrop for flowering perennials. Useful for screening purposes and will not reseed. A good choice for heavy clay soils. Plant in full sun and likes medium to wet soils. <p><i>Deschampsia cespitosa</i> 'Goldtau' Gold Dew Tufted Hair Grass</p>	<p>Airy chartreuse-yellow panicles develop hair-like awns in the summer, taking on a bronze-yellow thereafter. Clumping habit, semi-evergreen, fine textured dark-green foliage with thin stems. Likes moist soil and full to partial sun, depending on intensity. Is a cool-season grass.</p>	<p>H 1-2' W 2' Zone 3</p>	
<p><i>Helictotrichon sempervirens</i> 'Sapphire' Blue Oat Grass</p>	<p>Dense, spikey, dome-shaped clumps of needle thin, blue-gray foliage. Semi-evergreen in cooler climates. Plant in full sun with well-drained soils, low water needs. Is a cool-season grass.</p>	<p>H 2-3' W 2-3' Zone 4</p>	 <p><small>credit: Walter Gardens, Inc</small></p>
<p><i>Miscanthus oligostachyus</i> 'Purpurascens' Flame Grass</p>	<p>Compact, clumping habit. Foliage spreads out like a fountain. Silvery flowers emerge early in July and forms a shimmering display when backed with its orange-red fall color. Plant in full sun to bright shady areas, needs moist soil. <p><i>Miscanthus sinensis</i> 'Gracillimus' Maiden Grass</p>	<p>Rounded mounds of fine, silver-veined green leaves. Reddish-colored fan-like plumes emerge in the fall and age to a silvery-white. Golden-yellow fall leaf color. Plant in full sun with average, well-drained soils.</p>	<p>H 5-6' W 3' Zone 4</p>	 <p>credit: Walters Gardens, Inc</p>
<p><i>Pennisetum alopecuroides</i> 'Hameln' Dwarf Fountain Grass</p>	<p>Compact, clumping habit, early blooming warm-season grass. Arching fine green foliage and bristly silver-white seedheads turn buff as they dry. Plant in full sun to slight shade and moist, well-drained soils of varying quality.</p>	<p>H 2-3' W 1-2' Zone 4</p>	 <p>credit: Walters Gardens, Inc</p>
<p><i>Schizachyrium scoparium</i> 'Standing Ovation' PP25202 Little Bluestem</p>	<p>Reliably upright, metallic blue-green spikey foliage develops burgundy tips before transitioning to fall hues of orange, red, and yellow.
